EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

A Spiritual Way of Thinking

Gospel: John 6:24-35

"What must we do to perform the works of God?"

Jesus had the crowd pegged. They ask for a sign like Moses performed when he gave the people manna in the desert. This is a double affront, as Jesus has just given the multitude miraculous bread, and also because they are looking for the wrong kind of bread, the kind that does not last. So they ask for the bread that lasts, and Jesus offers himself.

Though Thomas Aquinas would later suggest that one can come to faith through reason, faith is not a "reasonable" thing. Faith is often described as a leap, a crossing through air, a movement over the gap that separates the worldly concern from the eternal. For the crowds to accept Jesus as the bread from heaven, they would have to lay down their expectations of who he is and what bread is. They would have to be willing to cross over into faith, and leave the material values behind.

Questions for Reflection

- * How has God been faithful to you? What are the signs of God's care in your life?
- * When have you been challenged to take on a spiritual way of thinking? Has this helped you to become a new person in God's image?
- Name some worldly hungers that you feel pulled by. What spiritual food does God give to fill you?

Action Response

Spend a week making decisions from the spiritual side of your mind. Before each decision, large or small, ask which response is better aligned with God's kingdom.



RENEW (mean) and RENEW-

Esther's Journey (women) are programs to help indigent prisoners about to be released, remain out of prison and contribute positively to society.

To curb homelessness and instability as people leave correctional facilities and to help prevent recidivism (return to prison), it is imperative that their identity (birth certificate, social security card and state ID card) is secured. To address homelessness (a prime factor in causing recidivism), Catholic Charities, besides assisting with the above-mentioned documents, will offer assistance for the first month's rent in a halfway house or any other safe temporary residence. The assistance given, coupled with a month's engagement of positive reinforcement dialogue, offer the newly released person a chance to renew their life and in many cases be away from people and circumstances that could impeded their progress.

South Carolina's recidivism rate is at 25.7%. RENEW and Esther's Journey have engaged 623 participants. As of 6/22/18 only 11 have returned to prison, translating to a 1.77% rate of recidivism.

Previously, the RENEW program was funded by a grant. The grant has been depleted and Catholic Charities is in need of financial assistance to continue this much-needed program. The funds expended per month, per person, amount to approximately \$150 and we provide service for up to 30-plus clients per month.
